KLEE is a state-of-the-art symbolic execution engine that applies a set of optimizations including different simplification steps (expression simplification, independence calculation) and caching (simple validity caching, counterexample caching) before it calls the solver. This showed tremendous impact on the solving process. In this seminar, a closer look will be presented into the solver chain, analyzing the impact of the chain in different scenarios.
